Collins stressed that while he is optimistic about the expo, the airport is still seek-

"As always we need volunteers," Collins continued.

The sixth annual Midwest LSA Expo is scheduled for 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Sept. 4-5.

According to the expo website, the event was created to educate aviators about all facets related to the LSA industry, including the many different aircraft types, available engines and LSA performance, to promote the sale of LSAs, the use of LSA aircraft for flight training and in rental fleets, and to promote economic development in the

Southern Illinois region.

Collins also continued to state that Mt. Vernon continues to grow in reputation throughout the aviation community. "I can't say enough about it," he said. "The public always comes and helps and rolls out the red carpet for our vendors. Mt. Vernon is on the map as the friendliest place in aviation."
