

Airport using Internet as way to inform public of operations

MT. VERNON — The latest information on the Mt. Vernon Outland Airport is no more than a click away thanks to its new and improved Web site.

The Mt. Vernon Airport Authority maintains an informational and interactive site to allow the public full access to its operations.

Airport Manager Chris Collins invited the public to log on to www.mtvernonairport.com to see its latest upgrades and take a tour through the links and pictures available.

Visitors can find information on the airport as well as the Air Evac Lifeteam, SRT Aviation, Civil Air Patrol, KR Gathering, Experimental Aircraft Association, related newspaper articles, community information and scheduled events.

Included on the site are minutes from the Airport Authority Board meeting from December 2006 through its

meeting Tuesday night.

Those in search of information on the airport itself can click their way to reports on the facility, approach information, airport emergency response team, airport layout and the airport board.

"Mt. Vernon Outland Airport (MVN) serves the businesses and residents of Jefferson and neighboring Counties," the site says. "The airport's modern infrastructure, highlighted by an Instrument Landing Sys-

tem equipped 6500' by 150' main runway, makes it an ideal location for numerous aeronautical activities. Cargo, corporate, charter, and recreational flying, as well as fixed wing and helicopter flight training, occurs daily at MVN."

Webmaster Don Lewis takes charge of keeping the site updated, adding airport board minutes and the overall look of the site.

"I can't say enough about the job Don [Lewis] is doing," Collins said.

Collins stressed the importance of the Web site and the ability to keep the public, potential clients and pilots informed on the offerings and operations of the airport.
