

### YANKEE LADY VISITS SOUTHERN ILLINOIS







The Yankee Air Museum's B-17 Flying Fortress "Yankee Lady", one of only three remaining flyable B-17's, visited the airport in late October. The crew of "Yankee Lady" generously allowed residents inside the aircraft to experience history and preserve the legacy of thousands of airman lost over the skies of WW2 Europe. Local B-17/B-29 Aircraft Commander Evertt Atkinson, 101 years young, was on hand to welcome "Yankee Lady" to Mt. Vernon. The large crowd allowed Atkinson to be the first to greet the B-17 crew and only approached the aircraft when Atkinson waived them out - an incredible show of local respect for the Greatest Generation!

### JOINT BASE JEFFERSON COUNTY



A ground-breaking ceremony was held on November 20, 2023 for Air Evac Lifeteam Joint Base Jefferson County. Air Evac Regional Management, City/County Officials, hospital administrators, fire departments, and ambulance services gathered for lunch prior to turning soil at Air Evac Lifeteam's new home at 500 Firebaugh Drive.
