indoor showroom at Innovation Park Hangar #1.

Innovation Park is a business and industrial development on the southwest side of Mount Vernon Airport, online sources state.

Airport Director Chris

Collins said that MTV Motorsports has a long-term lease with the airport. The concept of their business venture is not new, Collins said, since it has been successful at other airports in St. Louis and Springfield.

"MTV Motorsports

clientele will fly into Mount Vernon Outland Airport, sometimes from across the country, to view a particular aircraft or luxury automobile," Collins said. "Ryan and T.J. have the business experience, resources, and contacts to be successful."

Gary Chesney, chairman of the Mount Vernon Airport Authority Board of Commissioners, also weighed in Thursday on the new business venture.

"It's nice when local professionals step forward with an idea to promote their hometown and invest their time, talents, and resources," Chesney said.
